<b>Day 15</b> 1 Corinthians 15:50-58 (The resurrection of Jesus brings us victory over death.)	<b>Day 16</b> Acts 1:6-11 (Jesus ascends to heaven but promises to return.)	<b>Day 17</b> Ephesians 2:1-10 (We are saved by grace through faith, not by works.)	<b>Day 18</b> John 16:7-15 (The Holy Spirit guides us into truth and glorifies Christ.)	<b>Day 19</b> Matthew 28:16-20 (Jesus commands us to make disciples of all nations.)	<b>Day 20</b> 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (In Christ, we are new creations, reconciled to God.)	<b>Day 21</b> Romans 3:21-26 (We are justified by faith through Jesus' sacrifice.)
<b>Day 22</b> Galatians 5:1 (Christ has set us free; we are no longer slaves to sin.)	<b>Day 23</b> Romans 8:1-17 (The Holy Spirit empowers us to live according to God's will.)	<b>Day 24</b> Galatians 5:16-25 (The Spirit produces fruit in our lives as we walk in the Gospel.)	<b>Day 25</b> Romans 10:9-17 (We are called to share the good news of Jesus with others.)	<b>Day 26</b> Hebrews 12:1-3 (Fix your eyes on Jesus and endure in faith.)	<b>Day 27</b> 2 Timothy 2:8-13 (Following Christ may lead to suffering, but it is worth it for the sake of the Gospel.)	<b>Day 28</b> Titus 2:11-14 (God's grace teaches us to live upright and godly lives as we await Christ's return.)
